
From Monday, November 28: Change in Reception and Calling Procedures for Blood/Urine Tests

The reception start time will be changed.



<u>Due to the discontinuation of window tickets</u>, the current reception procedure will be changed.

The reception desk will open at **8:00 a.m.** Please wait in line and numbered tickets will be issued in order. Note that the reception desk is closed until 8:00 a.m.

The reception desk will open at 8:00 a.m. also for those with appointments at the Outpatient Chemotherapy Center.

The start time for blood tests will remain unchanged, at **<u>8:30 a.m.</u>**

After reception, a numbered ticket will be issued.



Numbered Ticket for Blood Tests


A numbered ticket will be issued at the time of reception.

Depending on your test, a urine cup may be given at the same time. Please do not lose the numbered ticket because you will be called by the number on it when your turn comes.

The file containing the information/schedule sheet will be returned to you.

Your number will be called on the screen next to the Blood Test, Urinary Test, Treatment Room.

The circled number above your ticket number on the screen is the table number. Please go to the indicated table and pass your numbered ticket to the person in charge. A sample of your blood will be taken.
